


Friends of Mendip Hospital Cemetery



The old Mendip Hospital Cemetery is an area of consecrated ground steeped in local history. Established in 1873 as a burial ground for poor souls from the 'Somerset Pauper Lunatic Asylum' (later known as the Mendip Hospital) it was finally closed in 1963. Since the year 2000 it has been maintained as a nature reserve by a group of local volunteers known as 'The Friends' but the cost of grass cutting, boundary hedging and repairs to the fabric of the Chapel continues to rise. 1. To be able to qualify you must pay an amount of income tax at least equal to the tax that the Friends reclaim in any one tax year. i.e. approximately one third of your subscription or donation.
